The USDA National Organic Certification Cost Share Program enables certified organic operations to be reimbursed on an annual basis for 50% of their organic certification costs, up to \$500 per scope of certification.

- Only eligible fees <u>paid</u> between October 1 and September 30 may be reimbursed.
- Funds will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis until they have been depleted.
- PCO does not accept or process cost share applications. The applicant must complete and submit their own application.

If your operation's address is in one of the states below, your application (form CCC-884) can only be submitted to your county's FSA office.

- Delaware
- Illinois
- Indiana
- lowa
- Michigan
- Washington DC
- West Virginia

If your operation is in Pennsylvania or New York, an application will be mailed directly from the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture (PDA) or New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets (NYSDAM) after it becomes available. Once they receive your application, PDA and NYSDAM will contact PCO to submit proof of payment and a copy of your certification on your behalf; you will not need to include copies of paid invoices as an attachment with your application. If you do not receive an application or have questions about how to contact program administrators in other states, please see the list above for more information, or contact the PCO office (814-422-0251).

Other USDA Agriculture Marketing Service Grant Programs:

Specialty Crop Block Grant Program – This program provides grants to individual state departments of agriculture to enhance the competitiveness of specialty crops (defined as: fruits and vegetables, tree nuts, dried fruits, and nursery crops (including floriculture)). Each state department of agriculture then distribute their grant funds to individual producers of specialty crops in their state.

NRCS EQIP Organic Initiative Information - The Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) works with landowners through conservation planning and assistance designed to benefit the soil, water, air, plants, and animals that result in productive lands and healthy ecosystems.
