**National Organic Program 7 CFR Part 205  
The National List of Allowed and Prohibited Substances**

**§ 205.603 Synthetic Substances allowed for use in organic livestock production**

(d) As feed additives.

(1) DL-Methionine, DL-Methionine—hydroxy analog, and DL-Methionine—hydroxy analog calcium (CAS #–59–51–8; 63–68–3; 348–67–4)—for use only in organic poultry production until October 1, 2010.
